Variety of projects

Because of our size, you'll be challenged and involved in a variety of projects – ranging from small, short-term assignments to large scale systems implementation. You'll be learning new skills and expanding your career options as you go.

Leading edge tools and technology

You'll work as part of a dynamic team using the latest software and hardware. WorkSafeBC's technology architecture employs a distributed computing model. The production processing environment consists of a single IBM mainframe (z/OS), over 300 Intel-based Microsoft Windows 2003 servers, and several UNIX (AIX) servers. These systems are complemented by approximately 3,000 personal computers throughout the province.

The principle corporate data store (DBMS) is DB2 on the mainframe. The standard DBMS on Intel Servers is Microsoft SQL Server. Data is exchanged between n-Tier applications and mainframe data sources (mainly in DB2) using the IBM DB2 Connect database gateway.

New business applications are designed and developed as Internet/Intranet based solutions. The primary tool used for development on the Microsoft Enterprise Server platform is Microsoft Visual Studio 2009 (.NET) and J2EE development on eclipse. Middle-tier business and data access components are hosted on a cluster of load balanced application servers, while UI components, written in ASP.NET, are hosted on a cluster of load balanced web servers. Communication between UI components and middle-tier components is done using web services.
