- excellent interpersonal, verbal, facilitation, and written communication skills
 - the ability to work under tight deadlines and manage multiple, detail-oriented tasks
 - post-secondary education in public or business administration, occupational health and safety, or other relevant quality management education, and two years of related experience, or an equivalent combination of education and experience
