The senior security architect takes part in defining, developing, implementing, documenting, and maintaining the technology architecture of WorkSafeBC. - Anticipate and recognize problems, analyze relevant information, identify alternative solutions, and make sound judgments toward solving the problems
- Gather relevant information about core business functions, business-strategic direction, information-technology capabilities and industry trends, by reading and analyzing business and technical documents
- Conduct complex and structured technology evaluation projects using standard tools, methodologies, and procedures, to manage tasks and resources
- Information security policy concepts and objectives
- Computer associates – Identity management systems
- Networking technologies (e.g. topologies, protocols and data communications)
- Authentication and access-control models
- Identity-management concepts and systems
- Single-signon concepts
- Applications architecture (such as client/server, n-tier, and object technology)
