## OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY OFFICER — AGRICULTURE

As an occupational safety officer (OSO), you will inspect worksites to ensure compliance with various safety and accident prevention regulations and practices. In addition, you will conduct research, participate in seminars, consult on accident prevention, and advise employers, workers and the public at large on health and safety related matters.

You have been involved in the operation of an agriculture production facility such as green houses, ranching, vineyard, orchards, or other types of farming or agriculture operations and have demonstrated leadership in workplace health and safety.

### As a qualified candidate, you're able to:

- conduct worksite inspections and/or identify hazards within the agriculture industry and direct corrective safety measures
- make and enforce timely decisions independently using sound judgment and knowledge and can effectively deal with emergencies as necessary

### You possess:

- five years directly related industry experience
- a diploma in health and safety is preferred, however, equivalences will be considered

**Balance and wellness.** As a leader in promoting healthy and safe workplaces, WorkSafeBC believes the health and wellness of our employees depends on a solid work-life balance. As a member of our staff, you'll have access to services that can help you get the most out of work... and life.

- **Health and fitness:** We offer many ways for you to keep healthy and fit. Our Richmond office includes a fitness program offering equipment and classes, and staff outside Richmond is reimbursed the cost of gym memberships.
- **Self-funded leave:** Contribute 20 percent of your salary annually for four years, then take the fifth year off and use your accumulated funds.
- **Earned Time Off:** Start with three weeks vacation, plus the ability to add another 13 days off.
- **Care and nurturing:** Take leave in one or more periods to a maximum of five years for the care and nurturing of your children.
