## SENIOR BUSINESS PLANNER

As a Senior Business Planner you will be responsible for strategic, tactical and operational information systems planning activities for client areas. You will direct various projects in order to define strategic plans, outline major client requests, improve business engineering and create tactical information system plans. In addition, you will recommend projects for inclusion in the budget while also establishing and supporting the measurement and evaluation process. As an agent of change you will lead the initiation and facilitation of strategic change to the business and its supporting information systems.

### As an ideal candidate, you possess the following:

- Diploma in computer programming, systems technology, or business administration
  - Three to five years of experience initiating, coordinating, and managing projects to completion
  - Experience presenting information in appropriate oral, written, and graphical format to a variety of individuals/groups including senior executives
  - Experience facilitating group discussions to meet objectives
  - Experience exploring and evaluating business and technical alternatives to meet business objectives
  - Knowledge of accounting principles and financial analysis techniques
  - Proficiency in MS Office Suite, including word processing and spreadsheets
- Proficiency in various computer products, including distributed and mainframe systems and software development tools
  - Aptitude for understanding technical planning documents
  - Experience in a claims adjudication environment would be an asset
