As you know, the current **Functional Capacity Evaluation (FCE) Services** Agreement expires September 30, 2010.

WorkSafeBC is in the process of implementing a new Request for Qualifications (RFQ). Any party interested in becoming a Provider for the FCE program and entering into an agreement with WorkSafeBC is required to go through the competitive process and complete the qualification documents. This includes current contracted providers. The RFQ documents will be posted on the www.worksafebc.com under 'Bid Opportunities' as well as BCbid.com in the near future.

WorkSafeBC anticipates the following timeline for the competitive process:

- May 25 – June 3, 2010 - Request for Qualification (RFQ) document posted
- June 24 – June 30, 2010 - Bid closes; responses must be submitted to WorkSafeBC

These are estimated timelines and WorkSafeBC will notify current contracted providers by bulletin when these documents have been posted.
