### ***RTWSS Agreement***

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As you know, the current **Return To Work Support Services (RTWSS)** Agreement expires June 30, 2010.

WorkSafeBC is in the process of implementing a new Request for Qualifications (RFQ). Any party interested in becoming a Provider for the RTWSS program and entering into an agreement with WorkSafeBC is required to go through the competitive process and complete the qualification documents. This includes current contracted providers. The RFQ documents will be posted on the [www.worksafebc.com](http://www.worksafebc.com) under 'Bid Opportunities' as well as BCbid.com in the near future.

WorkSafeBC **estimates** the following timelines for the competitive process:

Week of March 15, 2010 - Request for Qualification (RFQ) on BC Bid (WorkSafeBC) website

Week of April 12, 2010 - Bid closes; responses must be submitted to WorkSafeBC

Week of June 1, 2010 - New contracts awarded

These are rough timelines and WorkSafeBC will notify current contracted providers by bulletin when these documents have been posted.
