ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS it is desirable that employers, workers and the community at large be made aware of the need to undertake basic organizational and attitudinal changes in the workplace to reduce the incidence of occupational injuries and illnesses, and

WHEREAS the Province of British Columbia, through WorkSafeBC (the Workers' Compensation Board) and other provincial agencies, supports the efforts of committed individuals and organizations to develop and promote safer working practices, and to raise public awareness of workplace hazards, and

WHEREAS the British Columbia and Yukon region of the Canadian Society of Safety Engineering and the NAOSH Week Steering Committee — BC together with the British Columbia Government and its agencies promote the open communication of occupational health and safety information among workers and employers, and

WHEREAS Our Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, has been pleased to enact Order in Council 903 on October 11, 2002;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that the week of May 6 to 12, 2012, inclusive, shall be known as


“North American Occupational Safety and Health Week”
