- 1. NAOSH Week Activities In-House** — to show your daily efforts in relation to your company size and participation, including your presentation of the theme, variety of activities, and use of incentives or prizes
- 2. NAOSH Week Activities in the Community** — to show your daily efforts in relation to your company size, including your presentation of the theme, variety of activities, and use of incentives or prizes
- 3. Most Innovative Activity** — to show your creativity and innovative ideas
- 4. Media Events/Coverage** — to show the level of community involvement and media coverage (newspapers, radio, television, newsletters or other printed information)
- 5. Long-Term Benefits of Activities** — to show how NAOSH Week will make a difference beyond the actual week based on training sessions that were developed and conducted, extent of training (company wide/specific employees), improvements and future goals identified, demonstration of your company's commitment to safety and health in the workplace

 - Participation and awards submissions must be received by June 15, 2012.
