

Practice & Procedure Decision of the Appeal Division

Number: No. 25
Date: June 30, 1999
Subject: Delegation by the Chief Appeal Commissioner

1. Section 85(8) of the *Workers Compensation Act* provides:

The chief appeal commissioner may delegate in writing any of the chief appeal commissioner's powers and duties to an appeal commissioner subject to any terms and conditions set out in the delegation.

2. I delegate to Jill M. Callan under Section 96.1(3) of the *Workers Compensation Act* and Section 23(3) of the *Criminal Injury Compensation Act*, or pursuant to the common law grounds for reconsideration articulated in Appeal Division *Decision #93-0740 [Right to Reconsider Appeal Division Decisions (1993), 10 WCR 127]*, the power to direct that the Appeal Division reconsider a matter or that the applicant may make a new claim to the Board with respect to a matter.
3. I retain the powers, duties and authority delegated by me in this delegation and will exercise these concurrently with the Appeal Commissioner.
4. This delegation is effective August 3, 1999 until November 30, 2000, so long as the delegate remains an Appeal Commissioner.
5. This delegation is in addition to the delegations provided in *Decision #23 (26 November 1998), 15 WCR 105*.
