R4.25-1 - R4.31-1	These are the Protection from Violence in the Workplace policies that have been consolidated from the <i>Policy and Procedure Manual</i> into the <i>Prevention Manual</i> effective December 1, 2000. These consolidated policies are not “new” policies. They continue the substantive requirements for each <i>Policy and Procedure Manual</i> policy, as those requirements existed prior to December 1, 2000, with any wording changes necessary to reflect legislative and regulatory changes since the policy in the <i>Policy and Procedure Manual</i> was issued.
