My comment is perhaps more of a question: RE: 9.18 (2)(b) I do not understand the purpose of "provided there is no other pressure source or head pressure". Why the concern for more than one source of pressure if all the sources can be identified, de-energized and locked-out?

I would amend 9.18 (2)to read

If adjacent piping contains or has contained a substance that is hazardous only because of its pressure, temperature or quantity, before a worker enters the space, the substance must be controlled

(a) to meet the requirements of subsection (1), or

(b) by de-energizing and locking out the pressure source(s) and depressurizing the line(s)
