These two regulations, in addition to the proposed amendments, will help to ensure and enhance the health and safety of our youth and new workers.

3.23(3) should also include that "the employer must also insure that the worker is given a paper and/or electronic Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) copy of each WHMIS controlled product that the worker uses, or works in the close proximity of, for their own records."

3.4 (a) should read... An employer must (a) "ensure the worker and employer signs all training documents and the employer must keep all records of all orientation and training provided under section 3.23 and 3.62."
