Introduction to classification units

We group all firms into classification units based on the products produced, the services provided, and the processes, technology, or materials used. The base premium rate reflects the cost of compensation and prevention in the classification unit.

Description This classification unit covers firms primarily engaged in operating a shake or shingle

mill at a permanent location. These firms may load logs onto a conveyer; cut logs into rounds; split rounds into blocks; feed blocks through shake or shingle saw; grade, sort,

bundle, stack; store finished shakes, shingles or ridge caps.
