## Attention: Prosthetic Services Network

### Subject: Fee Code 1100590 – Consumables

It has come to our attention that fee code 1100590 – Consumables is not consistently used appropriately.

Consumables are items used for donning prosthesis, hygiene, and skin care. These items include prosthetic lubricants, lotions, cleaners, and personal hygiene items. Shuttle lock pins are also included in consumables.

Not included under Consumables are components such as:

- Cosmetic hose (Minor components and materials fee code – 1100589)
- Cosmetic gloves (Major components fee code 1100588 when over \$600 and minor components fee code 1100589 when under \$600)
- Residual limb socks including liner and nylon and shrinker socks (Socks fee code – 1225985)
- Suspension sleeves (Sleeves fee code – 1225986)
- Liners and seal-in rings (Liners fee code – 1189888)
