Subject: Abilities language workshop and registration

Abilities language workshop – virtual learning

Health Care Programs has received feedback from various health care networks that providers are seeking additional resources on applying an abilities-focused lens to their services.

We would like to invite all health care providers to an upcoming virtual learning workshop where we will apply an abilities-focused lens to a case study, from an initial referral through to discharge recommendations.

Who should attend?

Any contracted health care treatment provider seeking resources, clarification, and/or practice in using an abilities-focused lens and abilities language.

What to expect?

The online workshop will include a combination of presenter-led content and break-out rooms for providers to work through a case study with their peers. Provider participation in break-out rooms is encouraged. Participants can expect to receive a resource package ahead of the scheduled session.

The case study will include both physical and mental health diagnoses and physical, emotional, and cognitive symptoms. As participants will have a range of clinical expertise and scope of

practice, we will be providing two sessions. The first session is geared towards allied health professionals (e.g., physiotherapists, occupational therapists, kinesiologists, etc.). The second session is geared towards mental health treatment providers (e.g., psychologists and clinical counsellors).
