**Subject: Recent Public Health Order Guidelines**

Following the most recent announcement by the Provincial Health Officer we would like to reiterate the importance of maintaining safe treatment practices for providers and injured workers.

The hybrid model for program delivery allows each provider the flexibility to structure their program safely using a combination of telehealth and in-person delivery of services as appropriate.

As per the Public Health Order issued on November 7, 2020, group activities performed indoor are suspended; however, individual exercise or practice that allows everyone to maintain a safe physical distance are allowed.

With respect to Workplace safety, all businesses and worksites must conduct active daily in-person screening of all onsite workers using the COVID-19 symptom check list that is part of every business restart safety plan.

- Workplaces must ensure that all workers and customers maintain appropriate physical distance and wear masks when appropriate
- Extra care should be taken in small office spaces, break rooms and kitchens
