## Attention: WorkSafeBC-Sponsored Rehabilitation Program Providers

### Subject: GRTW Reports and Privacy Protection

The Graduated Return-to-Work (GRTW) report template has been updated to prevent over-disclosure of confidential injured worker information to employers.

Please upload the new report template (form 83D202) from the WorkSafeBC website at [WorkSafeBC](http://www.worksafebc.com) and please use this form effective immediately.

We would like to draw your attention to the two changes that have been made:

1. Only record the area of injury, NOT the nature of the injury, on the GRTW plan (the nature of injury is recorded on all other reports):
