Subject: Job Demands Analysis Requirements

We would like to take this opportunity to remind all FCE providers that travel to a job site is required when performing a Job Demands Analysis (JDA). A visit to the site is necessary to adequately understand and report on the quantitative and qualitative physical demands, environmental factors and psychosocial stressors. Please note that reports submitted that do not involve a visit to the job site will not be paid.

When a JDA assessment is requested as a part of the referral, it is because the claim owner needs an in depth understanding of the worker's critical job functions. The information reported on is used to make decisions, including the determination as to an injured worker's capacity to return to work. It is thereby fundamental that the reported duties are reflective of the work required, and an analysis at the job site was performed.
