Subject: *New* position in Return-To-Work Services

WorkSafeBC has added a new position to Return-to-Work Services to support injured workers during their recovery, to make a safe and durable return to work. We are pleased to be able to share with you this new position of **Recovery & Return to Work Specialist**.

The successful candidates for this new position have recently completed their classroom training and are now in various offices throughout the province. As a provider in our network we expect that you will have interactions with this role which is why we wanted to share this new position with you.

The role of the Recovery & Return to Work Specialist is not dissimilar to that of the Return to Work Specialist Nurse. This position will work alongside the Return to Work Specialist Nurses and will have the ability to refer injured works to physiotherapy, OR1 and OR2 programs.
