Subject: OR1 Lite Reporting Requirements

Variability in report submissions after an injured worker attends OR1 Lite have recently been noted; particularly if the worker was discharged from the OR1 program after the OR1 Lite block.

In the event that the provider utilizes the OR1 Lite option at the onset of the program, and the injured worker is then discharged from OR1 Lite prior to progressing into the full OR1 program, it is not necessary to send in both a discharge report and OR1 Lite report. The OR1 Lite report (83D193) as seen below is sufficient documentation.
