### **Subject: WorkSafeBC and the Physiotherapy Association of British Columbia Terms of Reference Document**

We are excited to let you know that WorkSafeBC and the Physiotherapy Association of British Columbia have recently signed a Terms of Reference document. The purpose of this document is to outline the basis of the working relationship between the two organizations moving forward with an intent to have open and meaningful dialogue on the challenges and opportunities providing physiotherapy treatment to Injured Workers.

Part of this includes the re-initiation of liaison meetings, where the intent is to have representation from not only the PABC and WorkSafeBC but also potentially a College of Physical Therapy liaison as well as regional representation from physiotherapists working with Injured Workers. There will be further information on the liaison meetings shared in the coming months, including a call for nominations for regional representatives.
