Subject: Request for Proposal

The current HIATS Agreement will expire on July 31, 2020. With the introduction of the new Early Concussion Assessment and Treatment program (ECAT) in April of 2020, the goal is to transition to a new contract for the HIATS program during Q2 of 2020. In addition, the HIATS program structure will be updated and the service renamed the “Post-Concussion Management Program” (PCMP).

There will be a Request for Proposals (RFP) posted in the coming months.

In addition to new interested providers, **all current contracted HIATS providers must respond to the new RFP if they wish to continue to provide services under the PCMP.**
