Subject: RFSQ #041-2019 for Early Access to Physiotherapy Program

To clarify: Early Access to Physiotherapy (EAP) Program will **not** replace or supersede the Physiotherapy Services Agreement (contract #59648).

EAP is a supplementary program developed for early intervention in work-related musculoskeletal injuries. Physiotherapy Services **will continue** to be delivered under the Physiotherapy Services Agreement.

Current contracted providers of physiotherapy services are not required to submit a response to RFSQ #041-2019 in order to continue to deliver physiotherapy services under contract #59648.
